TAXES

Billing: Taxes are billed mid year for the period of January to December

Due Date: December 31

Discount: 10% if taxes are paid by July 31.

Tax discounts and due dates are shown on Tax Notice

Penalty: January 1st of the following year a 1.25 % penalty is added to any outstanding tax and water on a monthly basis.

WATER

Billing Period - Quarterly (January - March, April-June, July-September, October-December)

Rates

Minimum charge for 3 months \$65.00/5000 gallons

Above 5,000 Gallons - \$13.00/thousand gallons

Any outstanding water at December 31 may be transferred to the Tax Roll and a 1.25% penalty applied for every month it is outstanding.

On/Off & Rate

Water on/off services are done by the town staff Monday to Friday. Contact the Town Office, giving minimum one day notice, to schedule water turn on or off date.

Summer Line Turn On - no sooner than May 1

Summer Line Turn Off - no later than September 30

Rate - On or Off - \$25.00/ea

Rate - Emergency shut off (Weekends & Stat Holidays) - \$75.

Outside Watering Restrictions

Properties bearing **odd number** civic addresses shall water **only** on odd numbered days of the month (i.e. 5th, 7th etc) from 6:00 am to 9:00 am **or** 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.

Properties bearing **even number** civic addresses shall water **only** on even numbered days of the month (i.e. 4th, 6th etc) from 6:00 am to 9:00 am **or** 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.

Town Bylaw Enforcement Officer will enforce these restrictions.

Bylaws

Enforcement Officer Bylaw #7/2003

The duties of the Bylaw Enforcement Officer include, Dog, Traffic/Parking, Outdoor Water Usage, Fire, House Numbering, Licensing, Liquid Waste, Noise, Swimming Pool, Trees, Public Land & Domestic Waste.

Dog Bylaw No. 1/2005

It is an offence to allow your dog to run at large. Dogs over the age of 3 months must be licensed. No person shall harbour more than 2 dogs. Excessive barking of dog(s) contravenes the Noise Bylaw No. 5/94 and is subject to a fine.

Please ensure you pick up your annual dog license. License fee is \$5.00 if neutered or spayed or \$25 if not. Getting a license enables us to contact you should your dog become missing or found.

Development Permits

Please obtain the necessary Development Permits from the Town Office for the following

- building a new structure
- addition to an existing building
- renovating
- addition of new deck
- replacement of existing deck
- demolishing or moving a building

Fireworks Bylaw #6/2005

No person shall sell or discharge fireworks within the Town limits without obtaining a permit authorized by Town Council.

General quiet time weekdays 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., weekends 11:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m.

Regulate the Operation of Vehicles Bylaw No. 16/94
